

Configuring Your Listeners Anonymous E-mail for Android Devices

These are instructions for adding your Listeners Anonymous (LA) e-mail to your Android phone/mobile devices.

1. Open your email app (like Gmail, Samsung Email, or your phone's default mail app).
2. Tap the **menu** (three lines or dots) → **Settings** → **Add Account** → **Personal (IMAP)** or **Other**.
3. Enter your email address: *your_Listener_name*@listenersanonymous.com
4. Enter your MXRoute (the company that handles LA emails) password. It was sent to you in an e-mail titled *Your New E-mail*. It is the same message that these instructions came in.
5. Tap **Manual Setup** or **IMAP** (don't choose "Auto-detect")
6. For **Incoming settings**, enter:
 - *Server*: witcher.mxrouting.net
 - *Port*: 993
 - *Security*: SSL/TLS
 - *Username*: *your_Listener_name*@listenersanonymous.com
7. Tap **Next** or **Continue**
8. For **Outgoing settings**, enter:
 - *Server*: witcher.mxrouting.net
 - *Port*: 465
 - *Security*: SSL/TLS
 - *Username*: *your_Listener_name*@listenersanonymous.com
9. Tap **Next** or **Done** to finish.

Note: Don't panic if *Server* is the only data your device requests for outgoing mail setup. Most setup utilities auto-detect the majority of the outgoing settings.
